	9th. Battn.		Lieutenant Henry Thomas YOUNG.	<p>At FLEURBAIX, FRANCE, in charge of Left Flank Party of 9th. Battn. raid night 1/2nd. July 1916. By meeting with thick concealed wire his party had much difficulty and were considerably delayed in reaching the final jumping off point. Again after reaching the wire under the enemy parapet it was very thick and though cut in places by our Artillery it still offered a serious obstacle. The chances of success for his party looked most hopeless but by his determined manner he finally got his party into the enemy trench in good order and succeeded in capturing four prisoners and a Machine Gun.
